

### Biographical Sketch

Peter Caines received the BA in mathematics from Oxford University in 1967 and the PhD in systems and control theory in 1970 from Imperial College, University of London. After periods as a postdoctoral researcher and faculty member at UMIST, Stanford, UC Berkeley, Toronto and Harvard, he joined McGill University, Montreal, in 1980, where he is James McGill Professor and Macdonald Chair in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering. Peter Caines is a Fellow of the IEEE and was elected to the Royal Society of Canada in 2003; he is the author of *Linear Stochastic Systems*, John Wiley, 1988; his research interests lie in the areas of stochastic, adaptive and large scale systems, and in hybrid and discrete event systems.
